

## DECLARATIONS FOR REGISTRATION APPLICANTS

1. An application for dental hygienist registration or dental hygiene practitioner registration must be accompanied by the following declarations made by the applicant for the purpose of section 38.2(1)(d) of the bylaws:

I hereby submit my application to become registered as a [dental hygienist/dental hygiene practitioner] with the College of Dental Hygienists of British Columbia and declare the following:

- a) I have read, understood and will remain at all times in compliance with the *Health Professions Act*, the *Dental Hygienists Regulation*, the CDHBC bylaws, and the Practice Standards and Code of Ethics established by CDHBC's board.
- b) I am a person of good character, meeting the ethical qualities expected of a CDHBC registrant, including integrity and commitment to caring for others.
- c) I do not know of any reason, condition or circumstance why I should not be granted registration.
- d) I will ensure that I maintain professional liability insurance coverage as required by CDHBC for the entire period of my registration.
- e) I will promptly notify CDHBC of any complaint, investigation, review or disciplinary proceeding that may affect my registration or licensure for the practice of dental hygiene or any other regulated profession in British Columbia or any other jurisdiction, and will divulge any relevant information requested by CDHBC.
- f) All information provided in my application for registration is true and complete.
- g) I understand that the submission of false or incomplete information in support of an application for registration constitutes professional misconduct and may result in cancellation of registration.

I make this solemn declaration, conscientiously believing all the above statements to be true, and knowing that it is of the same force and effect as if made under oath.

2. An application for temporary (visitor) registration must be accompanied by the following declarations made by the applicant for the purpose of section 38.2(1)(d) of the bylaws:

I hereby submit my application to become registered as a visiting dental hygienist with the College of Dental Hygienists of British Columbia and declare the following:

- a) I have read, understood and will remain at all times in compliance with the *Health Professions Act*, the *Dental Hygienists Regulation*, the CDHBC bylaws, and the Practice Standards and Code of Ethics established by CDHBC's board.
- b) I am a person of good character, meeting the ethical qualities expected of a CDHBC registrant, including integrity and commitment to caring for others.
- c) I do not know of any reason, condition or circumstance why I should not be granted registration.
- d) I will ensure that I maintain professional liability insurance coverage as required by CDHBC for the entire period of my registration.

- e) I am applying for temporary (visitor) registration solely for the purpose of participating in or conducting an educational program or course, or administering or delivering an examination or assessment, that is sponsored by an agency approved by the registration committee.
- f) I understand that I may only provide dental hygiene services in British Columbia for the purpose described above.
- g) All information provided in my application for registration is true and complete.
- h) I understand that the submission of false or incomplete information in support of an application for registration constitutes professional misconduct and may result in cancellation of registration.

I make this solemn declaration, conscientiously believing all the above statements to be true, and knowing that it is of the same force and effect as if made under oath.

3. An application for non-practising registration must be accompanied by the following declarations made by the applicant for the purpose of section 38.2(1)(d) of the bylaws:

I hereby submit my application to become registered as a non-practising registrant of the College of Dental Hygienists of British Columbia and declare the following:

- a) I have read, understood and will remain at all times in compliance with the *Health Professions Act*, the *Dental Hygienists Regulation*, the CDHBC bylaws, and the Practice Standards and Code of Ethics established by CDHBC's board.
- b) I am a person of good character, meeting the ethical qualities expected of a CDHBC registrant, including integrity and commitment to caring for others.
- c) I do not know of any reason, condition or circumstance why I should not be granted registration.
- d) I will promptly notify CDHBC of any complaint, investigation, review or disciplinary proceeding that may affect my registration or licensure for the practice of dental hygiene or any other regulated profession in British Columbia or any other jurisdiction, and will divulge any relevant information requested by CDHBC.
- e) I understand that I must not provide direct client care included in the practice of dental hygiene in British Columbia while registered as a non-practising registrant.
- f) I understand that to return to practice, I must meet the requirements outlined in the CDHBC bylaws for reinstatement of practising registration.
- g) All information provided in my application for registration is true and complete.
- h) I understand that the submission of false or incomplete information in support of an application for registration constitutes professional misconduct and may result in cancellation of registration.

I make this solemn declaration, conscientiously believing all the above statements to be true, and knowing that it is of the same force and effect as if made under oath.

4. An application for renewal of dental hygienist registration, dental hygiene practitioner registration or grandparented registration must be accompanied by the following declarations made by the applicant for the purpose of section 44(1)(b) of the bylaws:

I hereby submit my application for renewal of my registration as a [dental hygienist/dental hygiene practitioner/grandparented dental hygienist] with the College of Dental Hygienists of British Columbia and declare the following:

- a) I have read, understood and will remain at all times in compliance with the *Health Professions Act*, the *Dental Hygienists Regulation*, the CDHBC bylaws, and the Practice Standards and Code of Ethics established by CDHBC's board.
- b) I am a person of good character, meeting the ethical qualities expected of a CDHBC registrant, including integrity and commitment to caring for others.
- c) I do not know of any reason, condition or circumstance why my registration should not be renewed.
- d) I will ensure that I maintain professional liability insurance coverage as required by CDHBC for the entire period of my registration.
- e) I will promptly notify CDHBC of any complaint, investigation, review or disciplinary proceeding that may affect my registration or licensure for the practice of dental hygiene or any other regulated profession in British Columbia or any other jurisdiction, and will divulge any relevant information requested by CDHBC.
- f) All information provided in my application for renewal of registration is true and complete.
- g) I understand that the submission of false or incomplete information in support of an application for renewal of registration constitutes professional misconduct and may result in cancellation of registration.

5. An application for renewal of non-practising registration must be accompanied by the following declarations made by the applicant for the purpose of section 44(1)(b) of the bylaws:

I hereby submit my application for renewal of my registration as a non-practising registrant of the College of Dental Hygienists of British Columbia and declare the following:

- a) I have read, understood and will remain at all times in compliance with the *Health Professions Act*, the *Dental Hygienists Regulation*, the CDHBC bylaws, and the Practice Standards and Code of Ethics established by CDHBC's board.
- b) I am a person of good character, meeting the ethical qualities expected of a CDHBC registrant, including integrity and commitment to caring for others.
- c) I do not know of any reason, condition or circumstance why my registration should not be renewed.
- d) I will promptly notify CDHBC of any complaint, investigation, review or disciplinary proceeding that may affect my registration or licensure for the practice of dental hygiene or any other regulated profession in British Columbia or any other jurisdiction, and will divulge any relevant information requested by CDHBC.
- e) I understand that I must not provide direct client care included in the practice of dental hygiene in British Columbia while registered as a non-practising registrant.
- f) I understand that to return to practice, I must meet the requirements outlined in the CDHBC bylaws for reinstatement of practising registration.
- g) All information provided in my application for renewal of registration is true and complete.

- h) I understand that the submission of false or incomplete information in support of an application for renewal of registration constitutes professional misconduct and may result in cancellation of registration.

I make this solemn declaration, conscientiously believing all the above statements to be true, and knowing that it is of the same force and effect as if made under oath.

- 6. An application for reinstatement of dental hygienist registration or dental hygiene practitioner registration must be accompanied by the following declarations made by the applicant for the purpose of section 45(2)(e) of the bylaws:

I hereby submit my application for reinstatement of my registration as a [dental hygienist/dental hygiene practitioner] with the College of Dental Hygienists of British Columbia and declare the following:

- a) I have read, understood and will remain at all times in compliance with the *Health Professions Act*, the *Dental Hygienists Regulation*, the CDHBC bylaws, and the Practice Standards and Code of Ethics established by CDHBC's board.
- b) I am a person of good character, meeting the ethical qualities expected of a CDHBC registrant, including integrity and commitment to caring for others.
- c) I do not know of any reason, condition or circumstance why my practising registration should not be reinstated.
- d) I will ensure that I maintain professional liability insurance coverage as required by CDHBC for the entire period of my registration.
- e) I will promptly notify CDHBC of any complaint, investigation, review or disciplinary proceeding that may affect my registration or licensure for the practice of dental hygiene or any other regulated profession in British Columbia or any other jurisdiction, and will divulge any relevant information requested by CDHBC.
- f) All information provided in my application for reinstatement of registration is true and complete.
- g) I understand that the submission of false or incomplete information in support of an application for reinstatement of registration constitutes professional misconduct and may result in cancellation of registration.
